

Consistent Hard Work is Key as Rhenish Girls' High places 10th in Western Cape and 11th Nationally

The Class of 2017 proved that hard work, planning and preparation throughout the year is key to success in the matric National Senior Certificate (NSC) examination. For over thirty years, Rhenish Girls' High has maintained a 100% pass rate in the NSC examination and the Class of 2017 upheld this proud tradition through their diligence and commitment.

Rhenish was invited to attend the awards ceremony at Leeuwenhof for Top Performing Schools in the Western Cape where Rhenish placed 10th in the Western Cape for the 2017 NSC exams – the highest position we have achieved thus far.

In addition, the Star College (using the criteria: 100% pass rate, 90% Bachelor Pass, minimum of 20 learners per class, entry in NSC exams, A average for the school) ranked Rhenish Girls' High in the Top 11 performing schools in the country for their 2017 Matric Results.
