



**RHENISH GIRLS' HIGH SCHOOL
DISCIPLINARY MEASURES**

A debit system at the school deals with minor infractions of the Code of Conduct. Five debits will result in a one-hour detention on a Friday afternoon. Parents will be notified via email, fax or phone of the detention on the Monday before the detention. If a learner chooses to ignore the detention, she will have a double detention (two Fridays in a row). If she still chooses to ignore the detention, a meeting with parents will be arranged and she will have to attend a Principal's Detention that will take place on a Saturday from 8 – 12. If she still chooses to ignore this detention, a disciplinary hearing will be conducted.

Disruptive behaviour in classroom – anything that prevents learning and/or teaching taking place	2D
Disruptive behaviour on school property	2E
Insolence	2F
Rudeness to visitors and/or parents	2G

3. Three debits

Truant from registration	3A
Leaving the class without a permission slip	3B

4. Four debits

Copying homework. Allowing someone to copy own homework.	4A

Defacing school property	5A
Truant from a lesson (including lessons where teacher is absent)	5B
Punishment not done	5C
