Communication Tools:

- D6School Communicator - <http://www.school-communicator.com/downloads/school>
 - You should have it on your Smart Phone (and your desktop) you can download both or either on the above site.
 - The advantage of the D6 is that it uses Push technology to PUSH communication to you – you will receive alerts / red flags of VERY important school announcements to your phone or desktop.

 - News , newsletters, circulars, notices are posted here FIRST
 - Use this as your first port of call

- And, you should integrate it with your own calendar on your smart phone. It is a public Calendar. Mrs Hershaw will email you the link which you MUST OPEN ON YOUR SMART PHONE. It will then integrate with your existing calendar on your phone.

General
