ABOUT RHENISH AQUATICS



Rhenish Aquatics comprises - Swimming, Water Polo and Synchronised Swimming.

Rhenish Girls' High School has a proud tradition in the swimming pool. For as long as memory serves, our swimming team has held the 4M (four girls' schools in the Boland - Bloemhof Meisieskool, Paarl Girls' High, La Rochelle Girls' High and Rhenish Girls' High) swimming title. In addition, for fifteen consecutive years Rhenish were champions of the annual Boy/Girl Gala that was hosted at the Newlands swimming pool. Our swimmers have successfully competed at regional and national level with some going on to compete at a junior and senior SA level too.

Water polo is hugely popular among our learners and over the years we have participated competitively in the Boland schools' league and the Western Cape schools' league as well as at tournaments in Port Elizabeth, Knysna and Gauteng where our teams have played against schools from all over South Africa.

Our pool was severely inadequate - both for competitive swimming and water polo - and our girls had to train in the pool at Maties or Paul Roos and we could not host galas or water polo matches. This severely limited our training opportunities and the development and growth of these sports at Rhenish. The situation was further exasperated by the drought that decimated the Western Cape.

As part of our School Development Plan, an Aquatic Centre was planned and towards the end of 2018 ground was broken on this. Our Aquatics Centre was completed mid year 2020, but before our learners could become accustomed to these incredible facilities, the global Covid-19 pandemic hit and the pool - and school - went into lockdown.

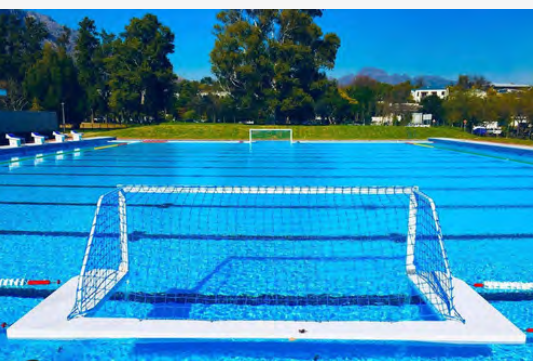
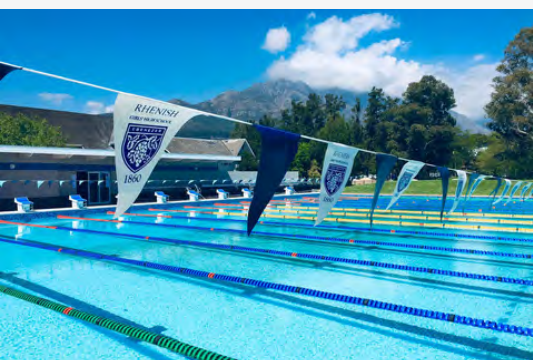
... OUR JOURNEY

RHENISH - A PROUD SWIMMING HISTORY

For over a decade and a half, Rhenish Girls' High School has been regarded as the top swimming school in the Western Cape.

- Rhenish Girls' has won all the 4M Galas 2006 - 2022 (except 2021 as there was no 4M gala because of Covid19). 4M is the name given to the competition between the 4 girls' (meisies) schools in the Boland - Bloemhof, Paarl Girls', La Rochelle Girls' and Rhenish Girls'.
- 2006 - 2019: for 15 years Rhenish Girls' won all the A league Cape Town galas, except for one gala in Cape Town in 2019 which we lost to Herschel Girls' by 1 point. During this 15 year period we swam on average 10 - 12 galas or swimming events per year.
- South African Level 2 (new level 3) Regional Championships - 2006 - 2022
55 Rhenish swimmers have featured in these championships
- South African Level 3 (new Junior National) Championships - 2006 - 2022
97 Rhenish swimmers have featured in these championships
- Top 5 in Age Group at South African Level 3 Championships - 2006 - 2022
25 Rhenish swimmers have finished in the top 5 in their age groups at these championships
- A Rhenish swimmer represented South Africa in the African U20 Games in December 2016
- A Rhenish swimmer represented South Africa in the CANA Zone Championships in February 2017
- A Rhenish swimmer represented South Africa in the Junior Africa Championships in March 2017
- Two Rhenish swimmers represented South Africa at the Junior World Championships in Indianapolis in 2017
- A Rhenish swimmer represented South Africa at the Africa Games in 2018 in Gabarone
- 2022 ex-Rhenisher "Best Female Swimmer" (based on FINA points) at the CANA Senior African Championships

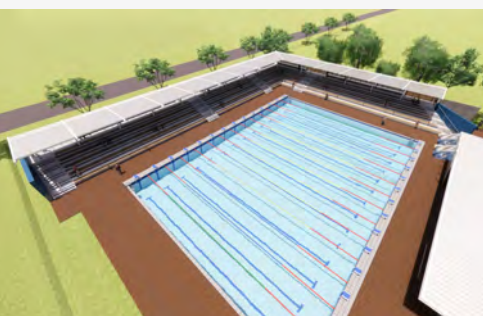
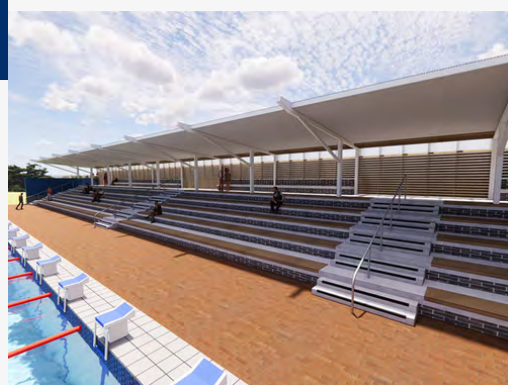

ADDITIONAL BENEFITS

In March 2023, Rhenish Girls' High School will host the Inaugural U19 Top 12 Water Polo Tournament.

This tournament will draw players - and their parents - from across South Africa and further entrench Rhenish Girls' High as a force among water polo playing schools for girls in South Africa.

The tournament will be broadcast on Super Sport Schools and will have wide social media coverage.

In a pre-olympic year, these U19 water polo girls will be eligible for selection for the SA olympic team and this too will draw interest to the tournament.

In addition, in the run up to this tournament, Rhenish will host both an U14 and an U16 water polo tournament.
